1. Provide a brief description of the embryology unit process.

2. What is the age of the youngest child?

3. Provide a description of equipment used including the incubator and housing of chicks. Attach photos.

4. Where is equipment located and on what type of surface/flooring? Attach photos of area.

5. How long are chicks in the building after they hatch?

6. Who will handle the eggs and the chicks? Will the children handle or touch the eggs and/or the chicks?

7. How will children be monitored around the eggs/chicks?

8. Are there preschool age children in the building? If so, what is the approximate distance of the preschool age classrooms in relation to classroom where eggs/chicks are housed?
9. Where is the kitchen located in proximity to the classroom where eggs/chicks are housed?
10. Where are meals and snacks prepared and consumed?
11. What are the policies/procedures for handwashing?
12. Where are handwashing sinks located? What is distance to where eggs/chicks are housed?
13. What are the policies/procedures of cleaning and sanitizing the area around the incubator/chicks?
14. List any other policies/procedures in place to control the spread of illness during the embryology unit.
